Scavenger Hunt Description:

Participants are asked to **take a new picture** (not off the internet or already saved on your devices!) with (or of) 15 of the items and/or places on the list below. **ANY 15 from the list count as a completed scavenger hunt.** Print the Scavenger Hunt objectives list out and check the boxes as you complete them.

All teams who submit a completed scavenger hunt by the deadline will gain one (1) entry into a prize draw the following week.

BONUS: Every <u>additional 15</u> from the list you complete will get your team one extra entry. If you manage to get all 51, you'll get a bonus of 10 entries (13 total).

SUBMITTING COMPLETED SCAVENGER HUNT:

- 1. Email your team's pictures, and the 15 (or more) objectives you completed to psw@gov.pe.ca
- 2. Please put "Scavenger Hunt [TEAM NAME]" in the email subject line.
 - a. For example, "Scavenger Hunt PSC Panthers"
- 3. Make sure you list or CC your teammates in the email, so we know who is on your team.

RULES:

- 1. Participants may go it alone, or form teams of up to 5 players. The prize will be shared evenly amongst your team, so smaller teams will be rewarded for the extra challenge of having fewer teammates.
 - a. Teams are welcome to split up and tackle different objectives to maximize efficiency, but *please submit all photos together in one email.*
- 2. The scavenger hunt officially begins at 9:00 AM on **Monday, June 16 and ends at 4:00 PM Monday, June 23**. That's right, you have the weekend to scavenge and hunt this time!
- **3.** Participants must email their completed hunts **before the end of the event** (submissions accepted up to 3:59 PM on Monday, June 23) to be eligible for the prize draw. The prize draw will take place later that week. Winners will be contacted.
